



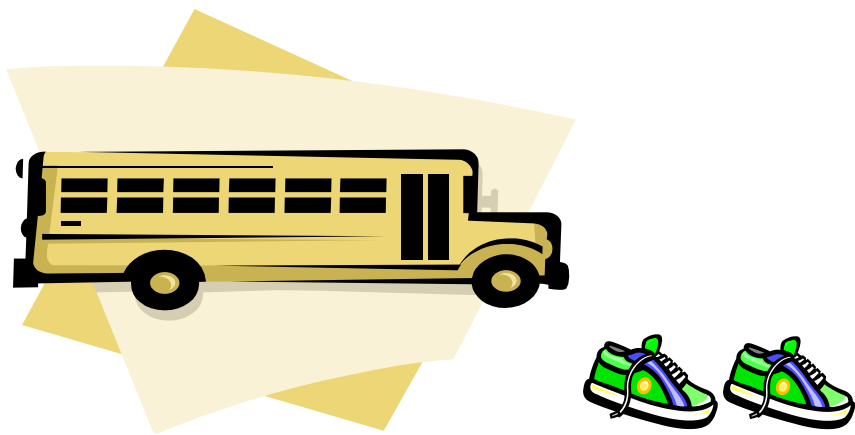

Some communities have started “walking school buses” for children, where a parent or other adult walks with children so that they can safely walk to school.
